The condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound John M. B. Moore Administrator of the goods chattels rights credits lands and tenements of Phily Moore deceased do make a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the goods chattels rights and credits of the said deceased which have or shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of the said John M. B. Moore or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for him and the same do make do exhibit to the Court of Ordinary of said County when he shall be thereunto required and such goods chattels rights credits lands and tenements do well and truly administer according to law and do make a just and true account of his actings and doings thereon when required by the said Court of Ordinary of said County And all the rest of the goods chattels rights credits lands and tenements which shall be found remaining upon the account of the said Administrator the same being first allowed by the said Court shall deliver and pay to such persons respectively as are entitled to the same by law and if it shall hereafter appear that any last will and testament was made by the said deceased and the same be proved before the Court and the Executors obtain a certificate of the probate thereof and the said John M. B. Moore do in such case if required render and deliver up said Letter of Administration then this obligation to be void else remain in full force.
